

Classroom Instruction Review

The Classroom Instruction Review will be a combination of classroom observation and file review. The review is to be conducted on each class once a month. The observer is instructed to review prior to the classroom observation these items in Teaching Strategies Gold: The “Class Profile” report, the weekly lesson plan being implemented the day of observation and as a follow up the child observation notes. The “Class Profile” report will give the observer the status of all the children along the check point continuum. Identify children who have been observed as not meeting the expectations according to the report. Then review the lesson plan to see if that domain is being targeted that week with an activity.

Choose a domain to target based on the outcome of the Classroom Profile Report (the domain that the majority of the children have been identified as not meeting the expectations within that domain)
